

Assessment rules (youth competition)

The children have to bring a valid passport to confirm their age!

The whole program has to be performed memorised and the pieces can be repeated in the second round. The time limits are set very strict and include tuning time. The number of participants is limited to a maximum of 25. The registration will be accepted after the money has been transferred to our bank account.

Program:

- Free Program of participant's choice
- All program has to be performed memorised
- Time limit:
 - **Group 1** (*2008 or later) **8-10 min**
 - **Group 2** (*2005 – 2007) **10-13 min**
 - **Group 3** (*2002 – 2004) **13-16 min**

Breach of Rules:

- In case the participant does not fulfill the requested program, he/she will lose **15%** of the average score, referring to the actual round he/she is evaluated
- Violation of **time limits** will cost **5%** for every minute (**playing too long, or too short**)

A scale from 0 to 25 points is used by every member of the jury for the competitor's evaluation. The highest and the lowest score have to be eliminated to calculate the participant's average score. The competitors can look up the jury's scoreboard after the evaluation.

The prizes for each group are:

- 1. Prize (not shareable)
- 2. Prize
- 3. Prize

Each group will be awarded with prizes from 1st to 3rd. In case of equal scores for the first prize the head of jury declares who will be awarded. If more people are awarded for the second or third prize, the winnings will be split.

The jury reserves the right to withhold prizes if necessary.

To receive the prizes it is necessary to attend the evening concert where the prize winning ceremony takes part, otherwise the prize will be passed on to the next finalist!

(The prize giving ceremony for both competitions is on the last day of the festival)

The Winner of the first price is obligated to play one short piece at the price giving ceremony!
